Dear Loyolites,

It’s lovely to be back in beautiful and friendly Denver after a period of distraction and rest and to find

that the problems of keeping the parish school open this coming year are staring us in the face.

The Archdiocese has kindly absolved us of paying the new tax that will be expected of every parish, which will be the equivalent of \$9,500 - while not providing the school with annual grants of about \$300,000. Due to various reasons, the *Taste of Italy* did not make much more than it usually did, in spite of gigantic efforts on the part of some to ensure its success. However, it was a great success in public relations, and we hope that various events being planned in the near future will bring in much support. I am sure that Loyolites will be able to come in, when they are most needed, with new enrollments and ways of keeping our expenses down. Please do all you can now, if your children benefited from the school in the past. Their success should be the reason for your commitment.

Loyola will continue to be a parish school until we are able to consider other options that are being studied by a Consulting Agency, to provide quality Catholic education to low income families.
